Ideal as a day-trip destination, a hub for a multi-day tour in northeast Ohio, or an overnight stop along the way, you'll find that Trumbull County is the perfect location for your next group tour adventure.

Trace some of America's history right here!

Visit the Ernie Hall Aviation Museum which bears the name of one of America's most well-regarded heroes and aeronautical pioneers due to his impact on the evolution of aviation. Mr. Hall was taught by the Wright brothers, trained many pilots during WWI, and received many accolades.

Walk along Millionaires' Row in the Mahoning Avenue Historic District and see stately homes and mansions from the 1800s. Visit historic sites such as the Trumbull County Courthouse, the Harriett Taylor Upton House, Perkins Mansion, and the John Stark Edwards House.

Learn about the local Underground Railroad movement at the Sutliff Museum. Take a step into the Victorian era and hear about the life and times of the Sutliff family who were active in the abolition movement.

Cruise through the National Packard Museum for a look at the history of the Packard Motor Car, the Packard family and other Packard enterprises.

Meet the 25th President of the United States, William McKinley. Born and raised in Niles, Ohio, McKinley was an enlisted Union Army soldier during the Civil War, the last veteran of the Civil War to become president and the first to use campaign buttons.

Experience new things!

Take a back roads tour of Amish Country and enjoy dinner with an Amish family in their home.

Watch a comedy magician perform his magic and card stunts with a little bit of humor mixed in.

See an art exhibit at either the Trumbull Art Gallery or the Trumbull County branch of the Butler Institute of American Art.

Meet future baseball stars at the Mahoning Valley Scrappers.

Swirl, sniff and sip a variety of wines at Greene Eagle, Country Porch, and Woodland Cellars wineries.

Roam with buffalo and experience the thrill of an African safari at Wagon Trail Animal Park. Bring your camera but leave your binoculars at home as you'll be within feet of more than 350 animals from around the world.

Get up close and personal with birds of prey such as falcons, hawks, and owls. Meet a raptor and waterfowl rehabilitator whose patients have been grounded by illness or injury at the Birds in Flight Sanctuary.
